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"My boyfriend's penis keeps slipping out."

Q I just started having sex, and my boyfriend keeps popping out when we do it. Can you tell me what's wrong, and how we can fix it?

A It's not unusual for a man to slip out during the deed, especially when things get really hot and heavy. All you have to do is take his penis, put it back in and resume the action.

However, if it happens all the time, which can get kind of frustrating, it's probably because his member's on the small side, or he's thrusting a little too fast and furiously. In either case, you can best prevent "fallout" by having sex in positions that allow superdeep penetration, like doggie-style or missionary with your legs up on his shoulders. (Man-on-top is also good if he can't control his inner speed demon; simply grab his butt and force him to slow down.) While woman-on-top lets you maintain the tempo -- since you're in the driver's seat -- it's easy for him to pop out if you move up and down his shaft. So, if you use this position, try gyrating back and forth or in circles instead.
